### Holotype repository changes for several recently described species of Mexican *Lampetis* Casey (Coleoptera: Buprestidae)

In the recent revision of *Lampetis* (*Spinthoptera*) Casey, Corona (2005) described seven new species from Mexico and Central America. The holotypes of four species were deposited in private collections. In accord with Article 72.10 and Recommendations 72D-F (ICZN 1999) and in consideration of different opinions about the deposition of primary types in public institutional collections, rather than private collections, I have received permission from these colleagues to deposit the holotypes of these species in Colección Nacional de Insectos, Instituto de Biología, UNAM, Mexico (CNIN) and the Florida State Collection of Arthropods, Gainesville, FL, U.S.A. (FSCA), as follows:

*Lampetis colima* Corona: CNIN (ex collection James E. Wappes)

*Lampetis hondurensis* Corona: CNIN (ex collection Richard L. Westcott)

*Lampetis viridimarginalis* Corona: CNIN (ex collection Charles L. Bellamy)

*Lampetis tigrina* Corona: FSCA (ex collection Gayle H. Nelson)
